

BASIC ASPECTS OF HEADSHIP

- **The Analogy of Headship** 1 Cor. 11:1-3
“But I want you to understand that the head of every man is the Messiah, and the head of a wife is her husband, and the head of the Messiah is God.”
- **Misconception: Head does all the thinking**
- **Both Head and Heart Think** Prov. 23:7
 - Prov 4:23 *“Above everything else, guard your heart; for it is the source of life's consequences.”*
 - Prov 13:12 *“Hope deferred makes the heart sick, but desire fulfilled is a tree of life.”*
 - Prov 16:21 *“A wise-hearted person is said to have discernment...”*
 - Prov 16:23 *“The wise man's heart teaches his mouth, and to his lips it adds learning.”*
 - Prov 20:5 *“The heart's real intentions are like deep water; but a person with discernment draws them out.”*
 - Prov 27:9 *“Perfume and incense make the heart glad, <also> friendship sweet with advice from the heart.”*
- **Head and Heart Think Differently**
 - **Head: Single Focus** □ **Heart: Four Focuses**
- **Head must care for the body** Luke 7:1-10
 - **Responsibility: Head's primary focus**
 - **Authority: a functional after thought**
 - **Attitude: Being "one under authority"**
