

Spending His Favour

“Now write in the king’s name on behalf of the Jews what seems good to you and seal it with the king’s signet ring. For a decree that is written in the king’s name, and sealed with the king’s ring, cannot be revoked” (Esther 8:8).

On March 16, 2019, in a message entitled *The Power to Accomplish Our Destiny* I shared that: “Scripture clearly establishes that favor (*chen* {חן}) gave Esther the power to accomplish her destiny (“for such a time as this”). We are to be excited for and love His favor. It is more important than money and fame. It is more important than hardly anything I know at this time.” Earlier this year, on January 8, 2022, in a message entitled *In His Favour* I shared: “I believe that the *Lord Yeshua* by *His Spirit* has been urging us to *function in His favor* (*favour* in the KJV) ... There is an appointed time to receive and accept His favor (*chen*) and the set time is now, in 2022. We are to gain favor with Him and favor with the people around us. Our future depends on this. Our success depends on this.” I concluded that message with: “Treasure his favor. It is what we need in *Kol Simcha*. It is not to be taken for granted. This is part of the *last days* revival. It is His pleasure to give it to us. It WILL take us to the next level. It will cause us to delight in Him. It will keep us in the center of His Will.”

In chapter 6 of her 2021 book entitled *Declarations for Breakthrough* Jane Hamon (who with her husband Tom are the senior leaders of Vision Church in Santa Rosa, Florida – a fellow Floridian) elucidates on the concept of *Spending Your Favor* (that is, the favor we have received from *Adonai*). She said: “*It is often said that faith is the currency of heaven, but favor is the currency to be used with people here on the earth. As we begin to spend our favor, we are given answers to those things we seek; we see doors opened and opportunities afforded. These are spiritual powers that bring natural breakthroughs.*”

We can have resources and money and not spend them ... or not spend them wisely. Therefore, there is a difference between having favor and spending favor. I stated emphatically in January that the set (appointed) time had come to receive His favor. Now that we have it through *Yeshua*, we must spend His favor wisely. Esther spent her favor with the *Achashverosh* which began the Divine Reversal of Purim, resulting in the saving of the entire Jewish nation. We are in desperate need of a Divine Reversal ourselves. It is therefore time to begin to invest wisely the favor *Yeshua* has given us.

If ever the people of God needed favor to impact our world, that time is now. We need His help in our nation, in our families, and to do the work to bring in the harvest of souls. But we need *favor with our fellow man* if we are to have *open doors* of opportunity and *walk in the influence that shifts cultures*. We are to come boldly before the Throne of Grace (*chen*) and ask boldly for what is needed—for ourselves and others. This is called intercession and boy, do we need it! We need to write a new decree, in the full authority of King *Yeshua* who gave us the authority: “*a decree that is written in King Yeshua’s Name, and sealed with King Yeshua’s covenant ring, cannot be revoked*” and begin to realize our destiny and start bringing about a Divine Reversal in our jurisdiction. I have seen evidence of this favor already happening among the people of *Kol Simcha*. Perhaps we will have the blessing of hearing testimonies about supernatural favor altering outcomes on our behalf. *Shabbat Shalom!*
